Insurance information for Harris Whole Health

Cheryl works in Virginia and holds licenses in Maryland, DC and WV.

Aetna:

-) Most Aetna HMO, PPO and PPO plans generally cover for <u>*medical* concerns</u>— when recommended by a physician for IBS, Celiac, gastroparesis, IBD, etc.
-) Occasionally plans have exclusions, so please do check with your plan that they follow this policy
- Aetna Better Health (Medicaid) is a separate plan. I cannot legally work with patients with Medicaid ***in any state***
- Aetna advantage—see Medicare section, usually not covered.

BCBS:

As of May 31st, 2016, Cheryl is an out-of-network provider with all BCBS plans.

More <u>about that decision here</u>. BCBS's actions were egregious enough that there is now a <u>class-action lawsuit</u> based on their actions.

Cigna:

-) Most Aetna HMO, PPO and PPO plans generally cover for nutrition for services of a registered dietitian
-) Occasionally plans have exclusions, so please do check with your plan that they follow this policy
-) *Cigna HMO plans through ACA with names like "EPO connect" and "Connect" generally have nutrition limited coverage. Check with your plan for more information.
-) NALC is different every year.

Medicare:

- Standard Medicare part B *only* covers for diabetes and renal disease type 4 with a prescription. I don't set these terms and I can't change them.
- Medicare Advantage plans: generally have the same terms as regular Medicare.
 If you call to ask about benefits,
 - The CPT code for a nutrition session is 97802/97803
 - o Ask if codes are covered for a Registered dietitian, not a doctor
 - Ask if codes are covered for gastrointestinal issues (I can give you codes if you don't have them)
 - Get a reference code confirming your coverage.
 - We'll need a pre-service organization determination notice of denial before we book a time, OR documentation that your plan has an explicit exemption and that you do have coverage

Medicaid:

) Cheryl is out of network, and cannot see Medicaid patients.

Tricare:

) <u>Tricare generally has limited coverage</u> except on bases. However, Cheryl is authorized as a "certified Tricare provider". This means that you may be eligible for reimbursement; please check with your plan.

United:

Cheryl is out-of-network and can provide a superbill.

CPT codes are 97802/97803 and diagnoses codes will vary.
